

One of the premiere events this year is the **Dance Opera** *Iphigenia in Tauris* by **Tanztheater Wuppertal Pina Bausch.** Commemorating the 300th anniversary of the composer's birth, it comes to Hong Kong as an exclusive large-scale, special event, performing nowhere else in Asia. Launched in 1973, the Hong Kong Arts Festival is a major annual Festival in the region and one of Asia's premier cultural events. Each year the Festival offers a broad spectrum of programmes, ranging from classical fare to cutting-edge productions. In 2013, the Festival presented over 1,500 artists in

some140 performances and another 200 PLUS events, including 13 world premieres and 17 Asian premieres.
