

Researched by Ruxmini Choudhury from the Samdani Arts Foundation, this new guide offers a comprehensive list of public and private organisations that are funding cultural mobility to and from Bangladesh.

Since 2012, the <u>Asia-Europe Foundation (ASEF)</u> and <u>On the Move (OTM)</u> have jointly presented the Mobility Funding Guides for International Cultural Exchange for the 51 **countries** of the <u>Asia-Europe Meeting (ASEM).</u> These guides provide a comprehensive and updated list of funding opportunities for the cultural mobility of artists and cultural practitioners in Asia and Europe, where cultural mobility is defined as "the temporary crossborder movement of artists and other cultural professionals."

The **Mobility Funding Guides** have been recognised by **UNESCO** in its 2018 Global Report as a "comprehensive and updated list [...] for the cultural mobility of artists and cultural practitioners in Asia and Europe".
