The Korea Arts Management Service will consider project proposals submitted by international festivals, arts centers, and networks who will implement a project involving Korean performing groups/artists as part of their performance program. The eligible project must be **either**:

1) a single festival or venue presenting a Korea-focused program featuring multiple Korean performing artists/companies

or

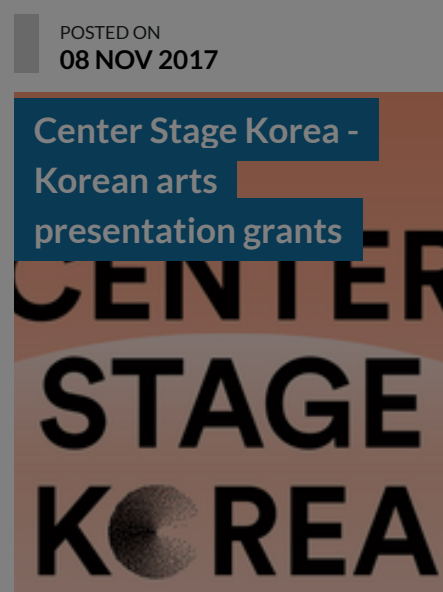
2) a tour arrangement featuring one or more Korean performing artists/ companies with co-presenters (partner organizations) in several venues.

The project must take place between March and December 2015
