 The project must occur between March and December 2015.

Who Can Apply

- Completed KAMS proposal application
- Additional documents or visual materials demonstrating previous projects



2) a tour arrangement featuring one or more Korean performing artists/ companies with co-presenters (partner organizations) in several venues.

The project must take place between March and December 2015
