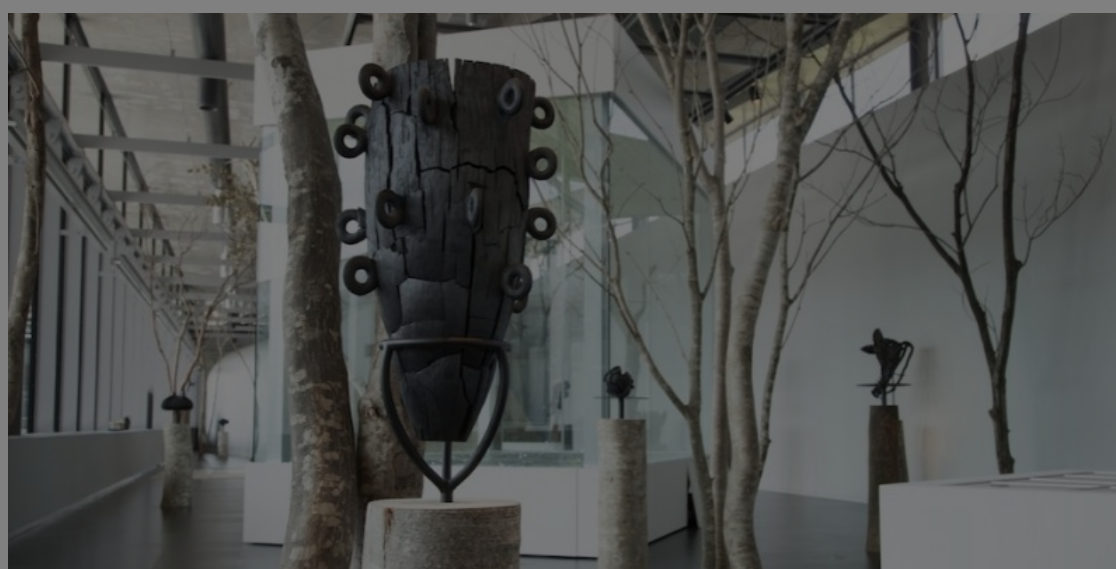

There is an entry fee for submissions and an opportunity to join an inspection tour on May 18-19.

Echigo-Tsumari is in a rural area of Tokamachi Region, north of Tokyo, Japan.

Approximately 10 projects will be selected.


