In partnership with C47 Investment, we launched the Momo Distribution Grant, dedicated to



Brief eligibility info (see guidelines for full details):

- 1. Director of the film must be of Southeast Asian descent and citizen.
- 2. Director of the film must have made a previous short film but not made a feature film.
- 3. This grant is not open to full time students.
- 4. Film must be produced in Southeast Asia. Southeast Asia will be defined as Cambodia, East Timor, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Brunei, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam
- 5. Submitted film must not be longer than 30 minutes
