Call for applications for **2017 MMCA International Research Fellowships** (see below for age and geographical eligibility restrictions).

This program was initiated as a part of the Cultural Partnership Initiative (CPI) Project supported by the Ministry of Culture, Sports and Tourism of Korea. Participants of this program have been mainly curators of contemporary art museums from all over the world.

This research program aims to provide a sustainable platform for initiating dialogues and for developing a comprehensive network among museum professionals.

1. **Period** July - November, 2017

2. **Host Institution** National Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art, Korea

3. **Inviting Researchers** 3 professionals

* Research fellow must present a final essay of his/her research at the end of the fellowship.
- Visiting art studios, museums, galleries and art institutions
- Meeting artists and museum professionals in Korea
- Attending art related conferences
- Cultural field trips
- Korean language course (mandatory)

5. **General Qualifications**

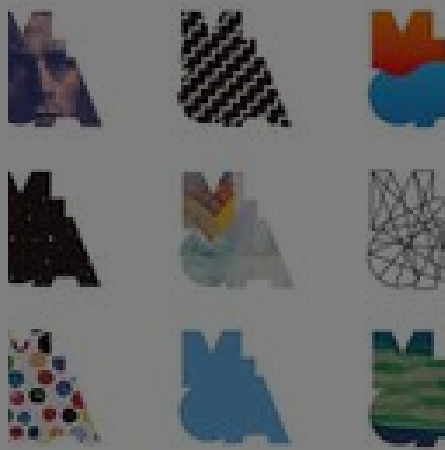
- Individuals who work in related fields of contemporary art such as museum professionals, curators, art historians, critics, conservators, educators, etc.
- Citizen of the following regions: **Asia**, Africa, Middle East, **Eastern Europe**, Central and South America
