

The UNESCO-Aschberg Bursaries Programme offers bursaries to artists for 2013 in the following fields: **Creative Writing**, **Music** and **Visual Arts** for residencies in different centres around the world.

The **conditions**, **eligibility**, **application process and deadlines** are **DIFFERENT** for every residency and bursary. Check carefully!

The bursaries are limited and are awarded on a selective basis. The pre-selection of candidates is carried out by the institutions. Artists must therefore apply directly to the institution of their interest, depending on the discipline and/or country sought.

General Remarks:

- Applicants may submit only one application per year and can participate in the Programme only once in their careers.
- Candidates who are nationals of the country where the chosen institution is located are not eligible.

The **first deadline is October 4** (for <u>Changdong National Art Studio, Korea</u> residency - open to visual artists around the world aged 25-25 yrs from outside Korea)

Deadlines for other residencies run up to the end of November.


