

The Selection Committee for the World Book Capital is calling for nominations for the World Book Capital 2015. This initiative represents a collaborative undertaking by key stakeholders in the publishing world and cities to promote books and literacy.

Each year, <u>UNESCO</u> and the international organizations representing the three major sectors of the book industry—the International Publishers Association (<u>IPA</u>), International Booksellers Federation (<u>IBF</u>) and the International Federation of Library Associations and Institutions (<u>IFLA</u>)—select the <u>World</u> <u>Book Capital</u> for a one-year period, effective 23 April each year.


