

The International Council of Societies of Industrial Design (Icsid) invites design-driven cities to bid for the **World Design Capital (WDC) 2016** designation. Applications are currently being accepted until 30 April 2013.

The World Design Capital, a biennial designation awarded to cities in recognition of design achievements for city promotion and development, embarks on its fifth cycle with the 2016 designation. Since its inception by Icsid in 2005, the WDC has increased in stature to become what is a highly coveted global title, garnering expressions of interest from every region in the world, and fostering citizen pride in the design accomplishments of WDC-designated cities.

"Icsid initiated the World Design Capital to help design-driven cities continue the use of design to further their social, economic and cultural development," says Icsid President Soon-in Lee. "Icsid takes great pride in the growth of the WDC movement, reaching all parts of the world and diverse sectors of the community and is excited to build further on the WDC legacy through the 2016 designation."

In support of the bidding process, the new 'Becoming a WDC' manual is also now available for download on the website, providing helpful background information on the programme, such as the organisational structure of the WDC, the application and project cycle and an outline of the WDC Signature Events.

Applications are being accepted from cities until 30 April 2013, with the World Design Capital 2016 city to be announced at the International Design Alliance (IDA) Congress in Istanbul (Turkey) in November 2013.







