Their professional enterprise, Phare The Cambodian Circus in Siem Reap provides career pathways for their circus performers and musicians. The Phare Creative Studio is a Cambodian Graphic Design and Animation studio.

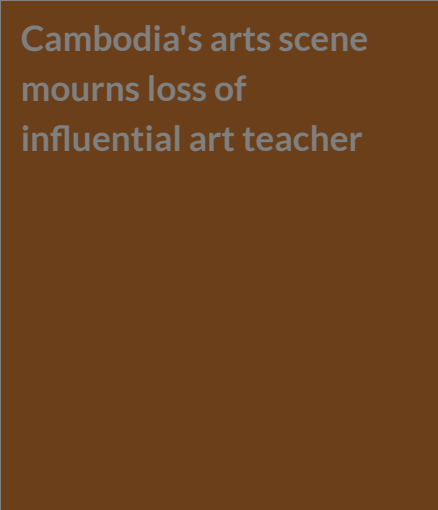
