Sipar's first actions in the field was to teach French in Thailand refugee camps and training in sites on the Khmer-Thai border. Arriving in Cambodia in 1992, Sipar has been actively working to fight illiteracy by promoting reading, publishing books, and making them accessible to the underprivileged population. They embrace 3 core values: innovation, transfer of knowledge, and sustainability. Sipar's works have received remarkable appreciation from government institutions, NGOS, and the public.

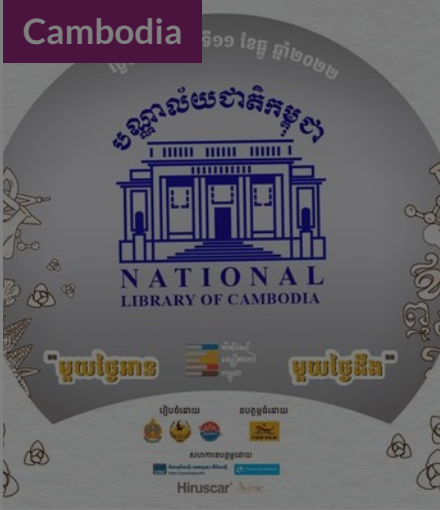

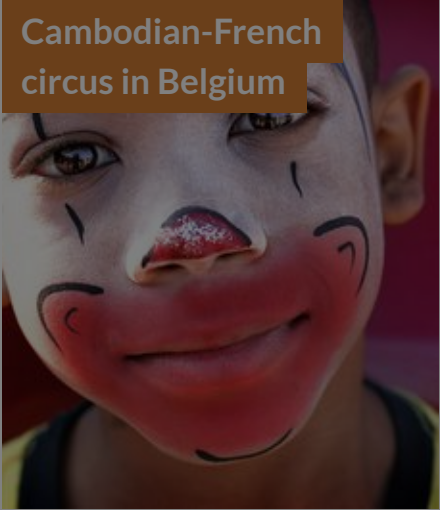
