Asia-Pacific Cinema Symposium and Conference this November

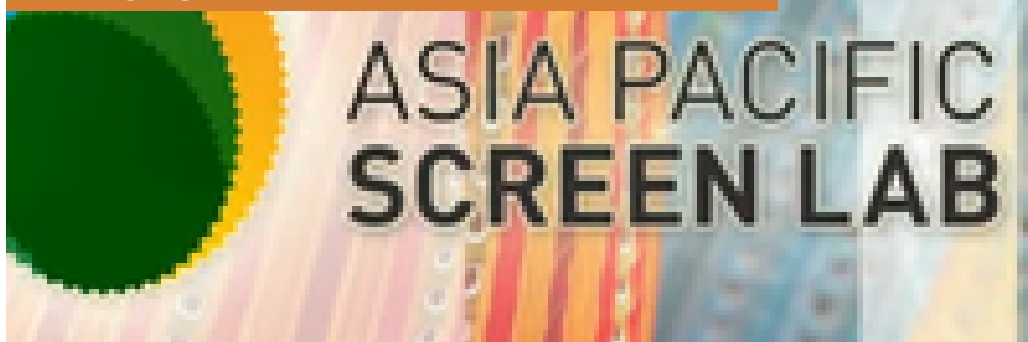
