DOK Leipzig Lake Festival also want to also create an **environment of concrete**

debate and discussion about the form, style, story-telling techniques of documentaries – not just an excited criss-cross of opinions about the content or theme. It is meant to seriously understand the different genres that in some way are at the bottom line of the various 'strands' in television networks across the world and in cinematic tradition. Through this and future editions, the festival intends to screen a rich variety and break down the definitions and creative pulse of documentaries that are termed as: Classic, Observational, Cinema Verite, Point of View, Ethnographic, Biographical, Historical, Investigative, Docu-drama, Archive-based recreation, Epic Essay, Poetry-based, Music-based, Scientific, Artist's Story.
