# ICHCAP Cultural Partnership Initiative 2019: Call Now Open



The International Information and Networking Centre for Intangible Cultural Heritage in the Asia-Pacific Region under the auspices of UNESCO (ICHCAP) has launched the **2019 call of its Cultural Partnership Initiative (CPI) Program**. The programme will enable **six young professionals in the area of intangible cultural heritage (ICH)** from the **Asia-Pacific region** to spend a **five-month residential period in Korea** from July to November 2019, with the aim of promoting bilateral cultural exchanges through Korean cultural experiences and specialised training. **What does the program involve?**

ICHCAP's CPI Program is focused on **building a long-term expert network to share information in the Asia-Pacific region and use the network for safeguarding ICH**. ICHCAP plans to enhance communication with domestic and/or international ICH organisations and NGOs to expand opportunities for cooperation through various means that involve participants conducting intensive study, participating in ICH practices, and delivering a mutual exchange for information. In this context, ICHCAP welcomes the participation of six ICH professionals of the Asia-Pacific region. The six selected participants will have an opportunity to engage in an international cooperation project and **carry out an individual research project related to using ICH information and enhancing network building**. In addition, the participants will be able to strengthen their capacity through **field trips to ICH-related organizations in the Republic of Korea and lectures**. Additional programs include cultural workshops and a Korean language course. This year's CPI Program is under the **support of the Ministry of Culture, Sports and Tourism of the Republic of Korea (MCST) and the CPI Secretariat (Korean Foundation for International Cultural Exchange)** with ICHCAP as an operating organisation. Since 2012, ICHCAP has operated the program to contribute to enhancing expert networks for ICH information sharing in the Asia-Pacific region while also seeking opportunities to create relationships for long-term project partners.

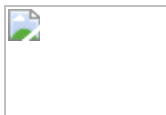

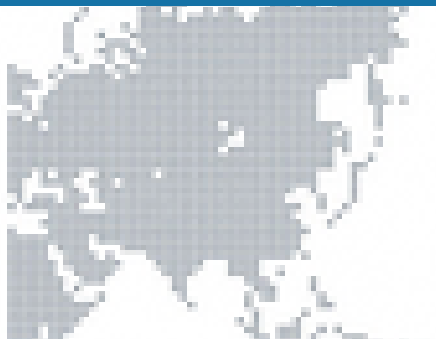
