The Singapore International Foundation (SIF) is organizing a panel session titled "The Art of Sustainability" on Friday, 7 October 2022, 11am – 12.30pm SGT.

The event will provide insights and approaches in galvanising action towards community engagement and environmental sustainability. It will also explore the role that the arts, culture and participatory design can play in being agents of change.

The panel is part of the annual Arts for Good (A4G) Fellowship organised by SIF which starts in October this year will take on a hybrid format. 32
