Singaporean director wins Fukuoka prize 2010



Theatre Director Ong Keng Sen has been selected as the

Arts and Culture laureate for Fukuoka Prize 2010. He is the first contemporary performance maker/ theatre director, to be given this award. Keng Sen is one of the leading theatre directors in the world. He has created a lively fusion, inspired by a contemporary sensibility, between the Asian and Western traditions and has earned much praise from a wide

audience.

The Fukuoka Prize is viewed as the most prestigious award in Asia. It was established to honour outstanding achievements by individuals or groups/organizations in preserving and creating the unique and diverse cultures of Asia. The aim is to foster and increase awareness of the value of Asian cultures as well as to establish a framework within which Asians can learn from, and share with, each other.

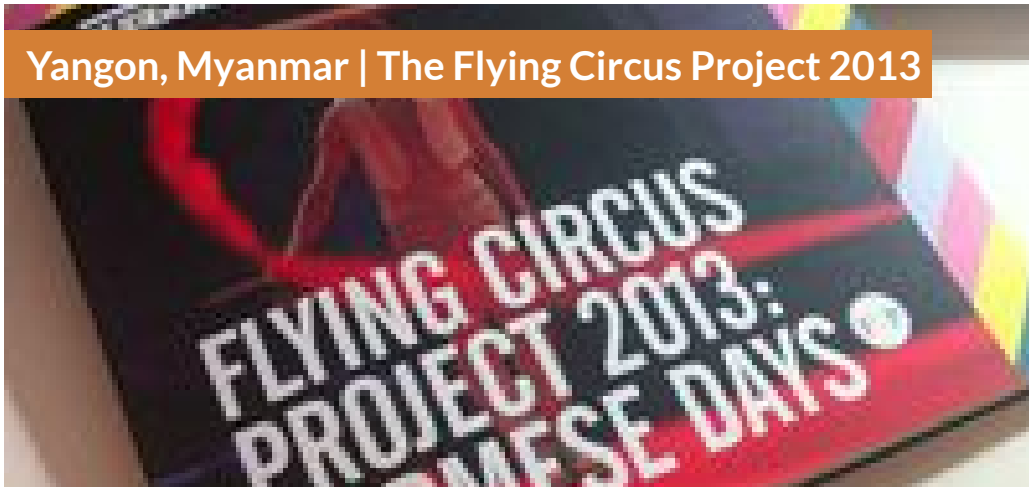
