- 2. Degree of interest in the objectives of IFACCA as demonstrated by participation in the Federation or sharing of information with the network*
- 3. Financial need (based on the GDP of your country).*

We would also like to remind you that Early Bird registration rates (10% discount on the standard rate) are only available until Thursday 30 June.
