Korea hosts an international research program for museum professionals including curators, art critics, conservators, exhibition designers, educators etc. Three professionals will be selected for the 2013 programme (6 month programme duration).

Participants of this program have been mainly curators of art museums from all over the world.

This research program aims to provide a sustained platform for initiating dialogues; for developing a comprehensive network among museum professionals; and for furthering collaboration and joint programming among art museums in Asia, Africa, Middle East and South America.


