

In Australia they showcase stories, present a multiplicity of perspectives, and explore contemporary concerns and ideas that influence how we, as a nation, engage with Asia. They have a particular focus on art that addresses Asian-Australian experiences and the contributions that diverse Asian migration has made — and continues to make — in shaping Australia. 4A's focus in Asia is to promote the breadth of Australian artistic talent, seeking to build an image of Australia that is open, progressive and fundamentally connected with our Asian neighbours.
