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The Central Asian Culture and Arts Network (CACAN) aims to create a positive social environment for **cooperation among Central Asian cultural and art workers**.

Establishing contacts among specialists in the scientific, research and performing spheres of Central Asia, the network will provide the basis for cooperation and co-creation in the region; it will develop mutual tolerance and a wider understanding of culture and art; and it will also promote information about festivals, seminars, international cooperation, and the participation of regional teams in international projects.
