The foreign participating dance groups are selected by a selection committee consisting of Officers from the Cultural Services of the Ministry of Education and Culture, the Chief Executive of Rialto Theatre and two local contemporary dance professionals. The Committee works very closely with the Cultural Attachés of foreign embassies in terms of attracting performances of international calibre. International artists are brought together with local dance groups, thus forging relationships and providing a base for collaborations and exchanges.
