At the annual meetings they exchange information about projects, developments, ideas and tools,

not just in the field of documentation, digitisation, and information databases but also in law, public relation, audience development, artistic mobility and more. As each meeting is hosted by one member organisation, it is a unique possibility to learn details about how they run their organisation.

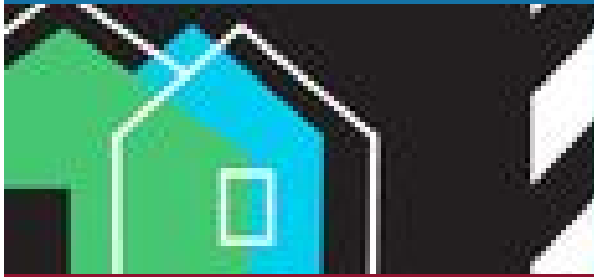
