In other words, the experience of Western classical music as a historical process may help to revitalise the same consciousness in the Cambodian people concerning their own classical music traditions.

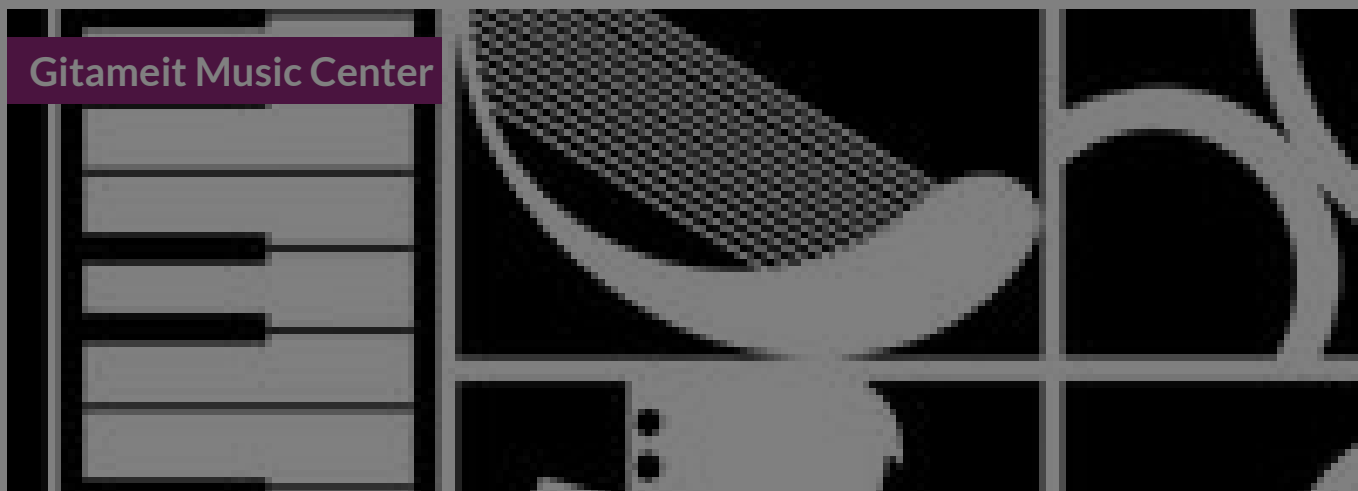
