It is the embodiment of **intercommunal cooperation**, contributing to the collective efforts of civil society in their engagement with **peacebuilding and intercultural dialogue**. Using its sources it encourages people to cooperate with each other beyond constraints and dividing lines.

The Home for Cooperation essentially aims to act as a bridge-builder between separated communities, memories and visions. It provides working spaces and opportunities for non-governmental organisations and individuals to design and implement innovative projects.

Today the Home has become a landmark building within the Ledra Palace crossing, UN buffer zone. It facilitates situations for **people to get together and to get to know each other**. The Home hosts an extensive variety of **cultural**, **artistic and educational programmes** with the aim to foster creativity and intercultural trust in Cyprus and internationally.


