- **The National Museum of Modern Art in Kyoto**
- **The National Museum of Western Art**
- **The National Museum of Art in Osaka**
- **The National Art Centre in Tokyo**

Its mandate is to carry out diverse and distinctive activities while respecting the character of the respective museums.

Collection The collection comprises 40,000 works including **paintings**, prints, watercolors, drawings, **sculptures** and **photographs**. The collection also as 65,600 films.

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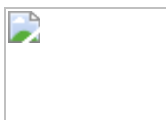
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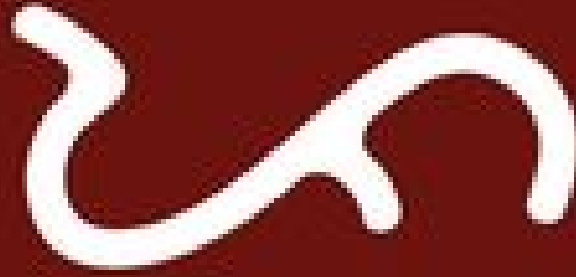


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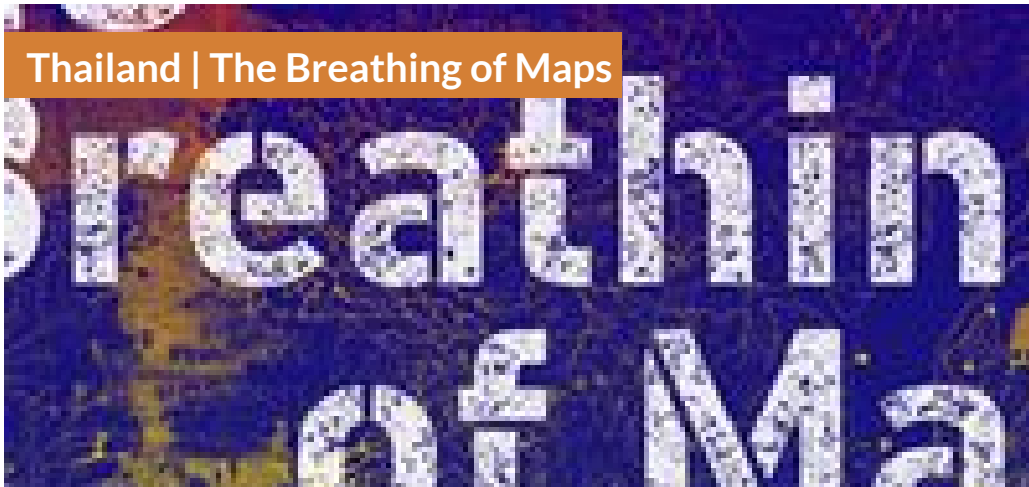
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
