The aim is the creation and development of arts and culture, and the cultivation of the aesthetic sense among the Japanese. As the hub of art promotion, the organization operates five art museums:

- The National Museum of Modern Art in Tokyo
- The National Museum of Modern Art in Kyoto
- The National Museum of Western Art
- The National Museum of Art in Osaka
- The National Art Centre in Tokyo

Its mandate is to carry out diverse and distinctive activities while respecting the character of the respective museums.

Collection The collection comprises 40,000 works including **paintings**, prints, watercolors, drawings, **sculptures** and **photographs**. The collection also as 65.600 films.


