

They work to stimulate the quality, development and context of the contemporary performing arts, in all their diversity.

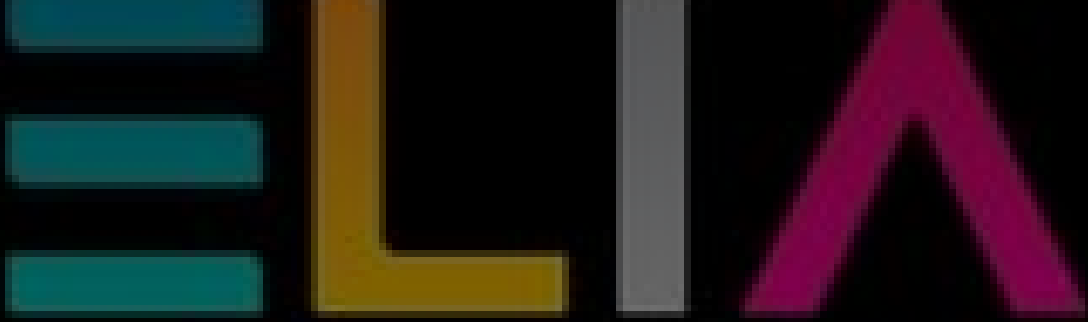

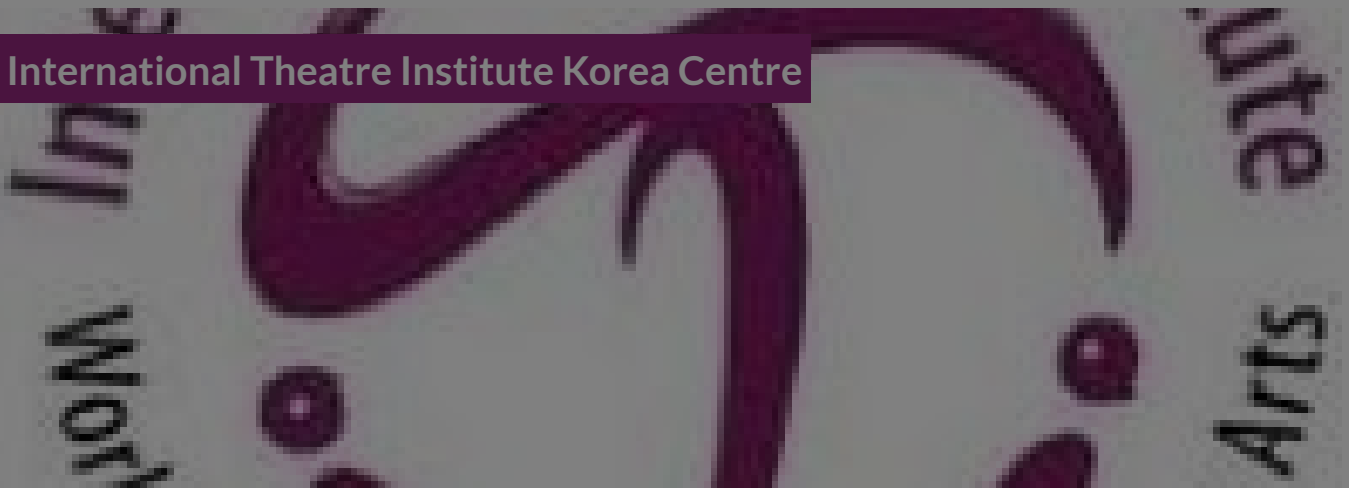
