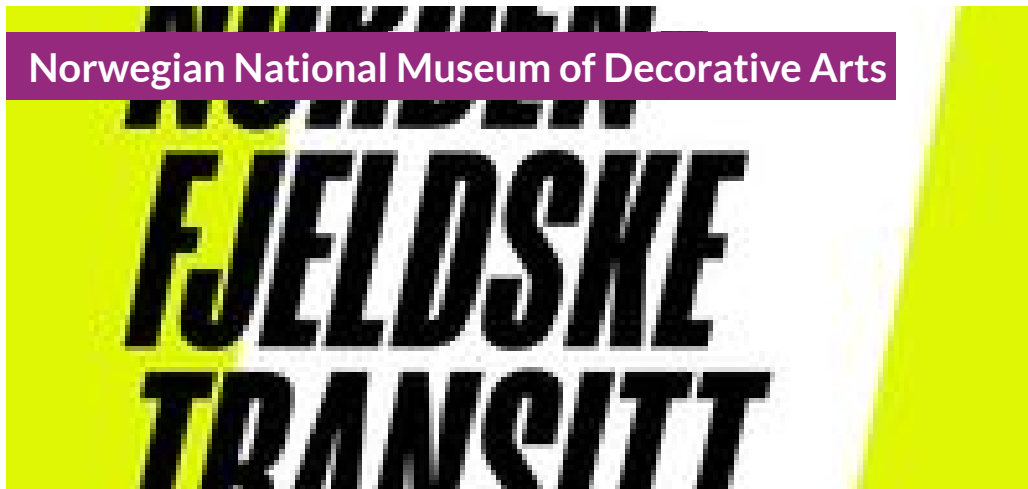
and porcelain, graphic arts and photography, furniture, metals, textiles, fashion and toys).
