The National Arts Council (NAC) was set up as a Statutory Board in September 1991 to spearhead the development of the arts in Singapore. Its **mission** is to nurture the arts and make it an integral part of people's lives in Singapore. Anchored on the twin strategies of excellence and engagement in the arts, the Council aims to build a vibrant arts sector by

creating a conducive environment where the arts is accessible to all and artistic talents have the necessary resources and capabilities to excel and achieve sustainability in the long term.

There work to support the Performing Arts, Visual Arts, and Literary Arts. Their divisions work with each other to implement strategies and programmes to better the art scene in Singapore. NAC is known for organising the annual Singapore Arts Festival, Singapore Bienalle, Singapore Writers' Festival and the Singapore Art Show.


