creating a conducive environment where the arts is accessible to all and artistic talents have the necessary resources and capabilities to excel and achieve sustainability in the long term.

There work to support the Performing Arts, Visual Arts, and Literary Arts. Their divisions work with each other to implement strategies and programmes to better the art scene in Singapore. NAC is known for organising the annual Singapore Arts Festival, Singapore Biennale, Singapore Writers' Festival and the Singapore Art Show.
